

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#### BRAINY BOX 1



Week 1: If you don't have a set place for your child's toys, take the time this week to designate a bin or a shelf that your child can reach. If possible, segregate different kinds of toys - ex., blocks, cars, dinosaurs, dolls. Involve your child in choosing which toys go together. You can draw a picture on bond paper and tape it to the bin so that your child will know where to put the toys. Play the cleanup song after your child will finishes playing. Put eway the toys together. Have another fun activity scheduled after playtime; otherwise, the child might want to take out toys from another bin, even as ha/she puts other toys awayt. You can sing the cleanup song with your child and reinforce the orderly behavior by exclaiming how easy it is to find toys when the next play session begins.

Week 2: Set aside a placemat for the use of your toddler. Put it in a place that he/she can reach. Have the child fatch the placemat every meal time and put it on the table. After eating, give the child a damp cloth to whe clean the placemat and a dry one to where it dry. Then he/she can put it back in its place. If a high chair is being used and the placemat cannot fit on it, you may just give the child the damp and dry cloths to whipe the surface of the eating area (if does not need to be so clear; you can clean it again later.) Don't forget to praise your child.


