PAREF was founded by a group *of PARENTS for PARENTS* in 1976 who value their role as their child's primary educator.

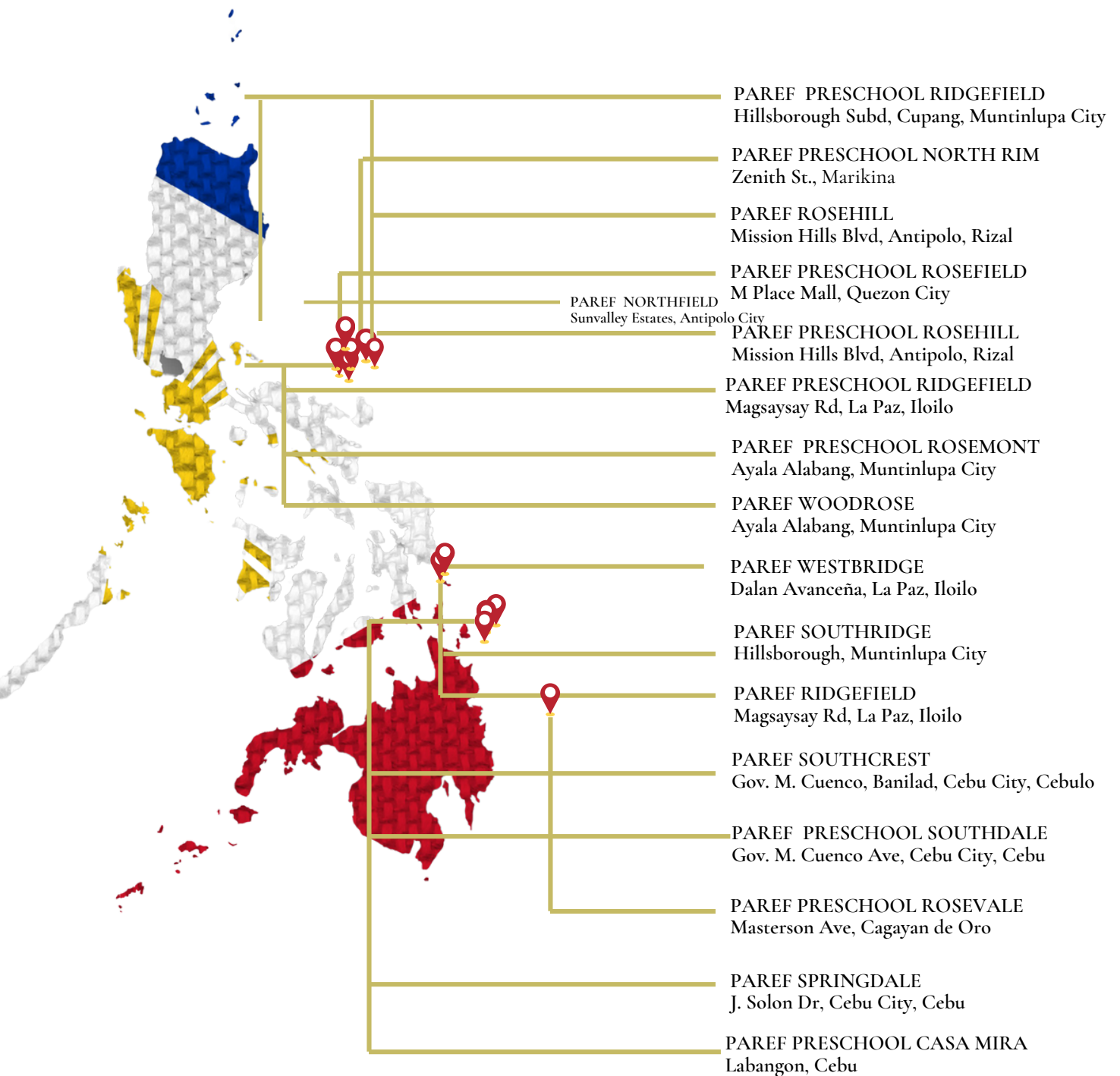

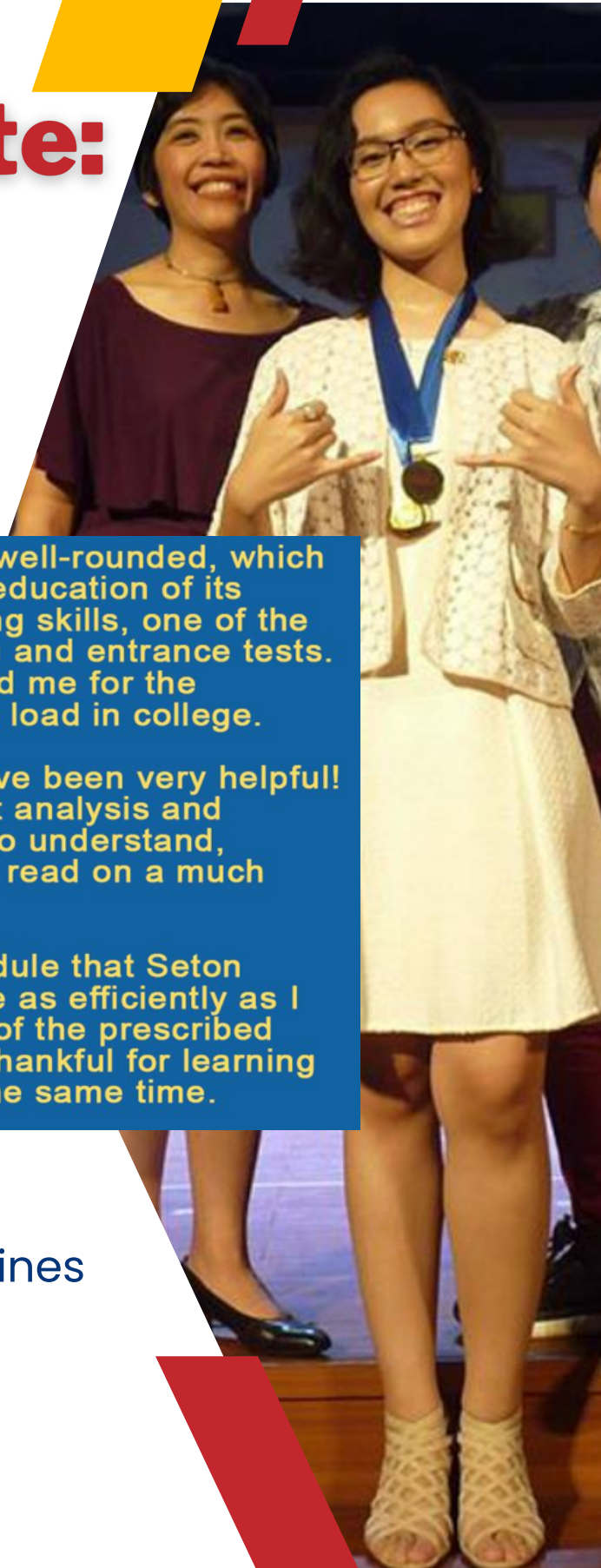
From a Seton Graduate:

Student Formation: Mentoring

The mentor personally guides and forms the child (behavior, relations with peers, management of emotions, etc)

Regular mentoring chats are scheduled twice a month.

Boys will be mentored by teachers from Northfield, while girls will be mentored by teachers from Rosehill.

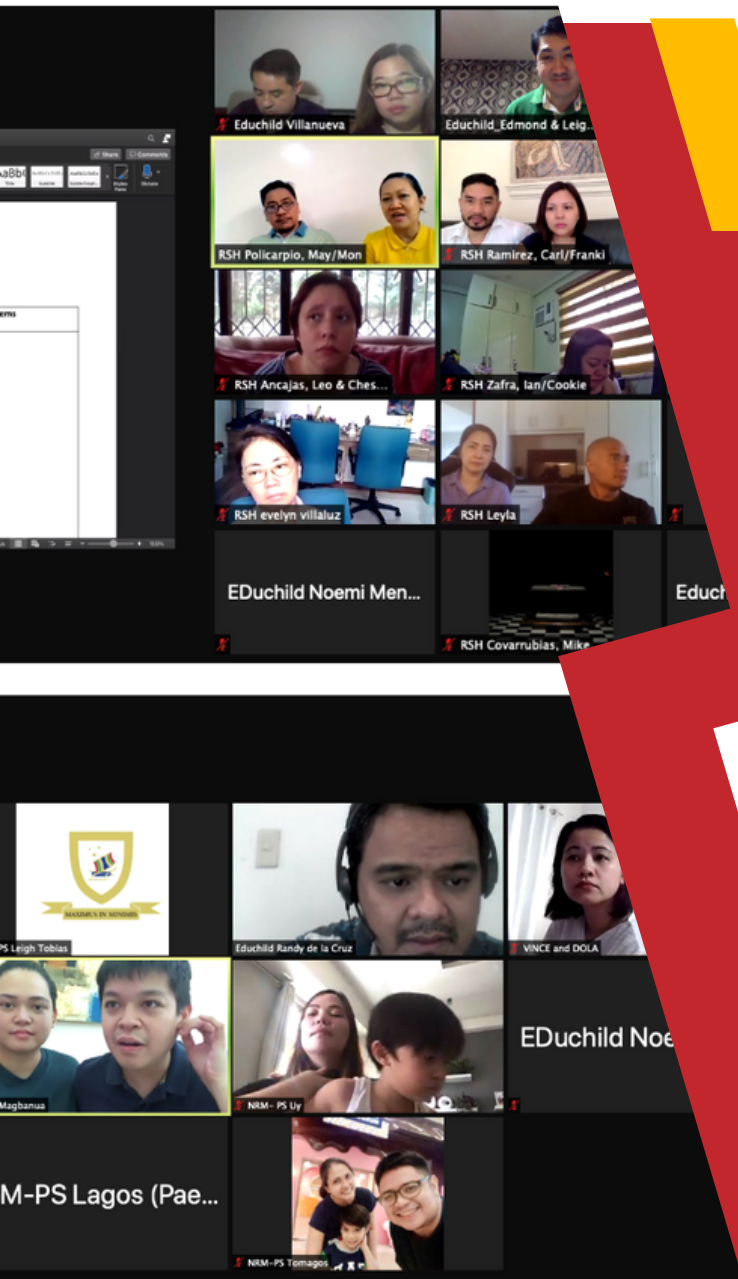

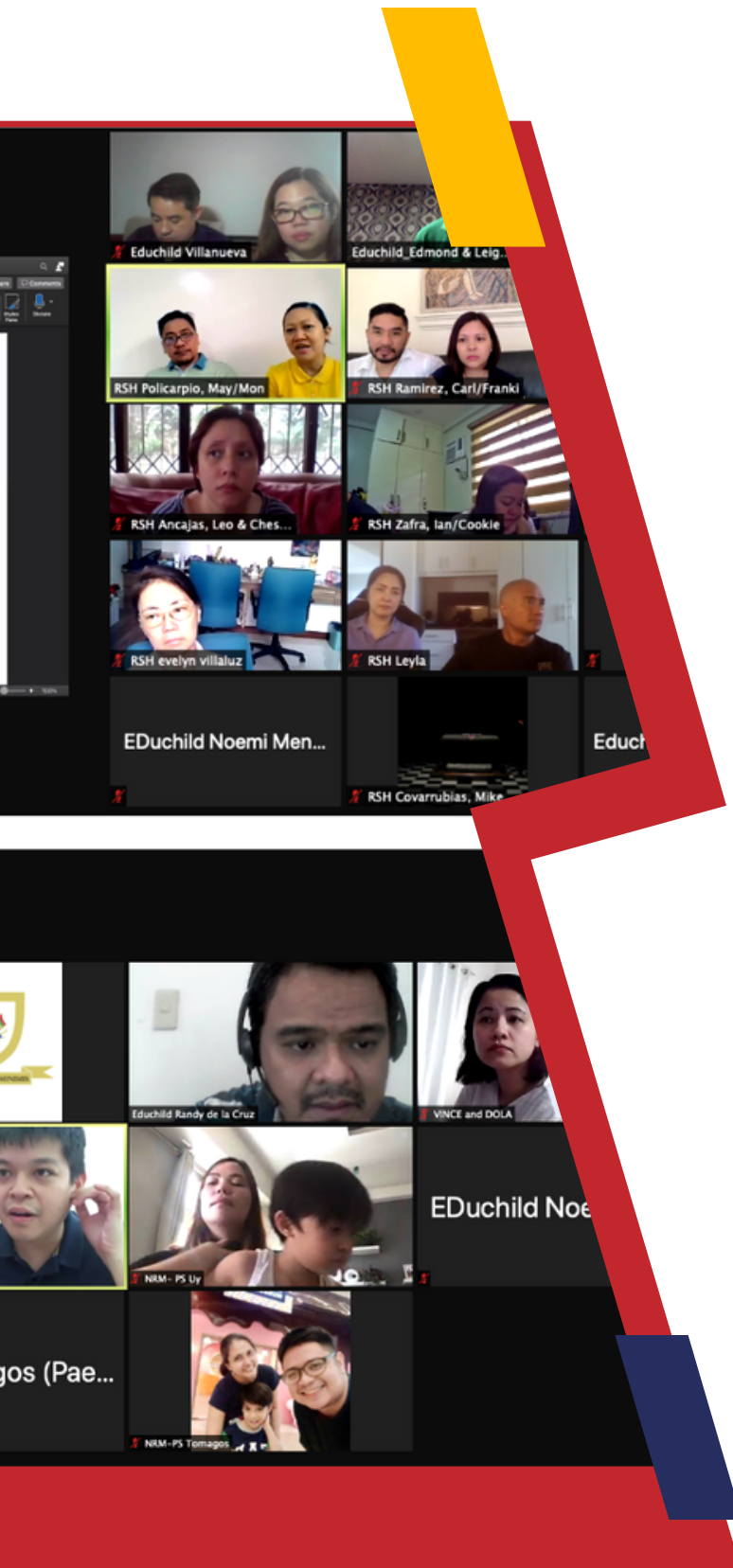

Parenting course that helps parents become **BETTER PARENTS**

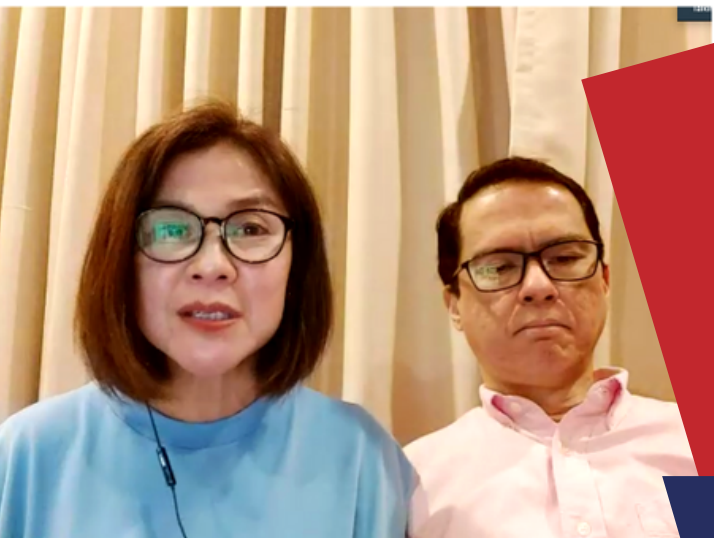
Lays the foundation for an **EFFECTIVE PARTNERSHIP** between the parents and the school towards an integral development of their children by providing parental formation to new parents
